Register

If you work in Riverside, San Bernadino, or San Diego County, there are separate requirements to earn your California Food Handlers Card.

2

Complete the Training

Complete the 60 min online food handler course on any device in English or Spanish.

3

Study

California requires Food Handlers to earn a CA Food Handlers Certificate (also known as a Food Handlers Card, Permit or License) within 30 days from the date of hire.

4

Take the Test

Take the food handlers test online, only 70% to Pass. Retake the test for free if you don't pass.

5

Get your Certificate!

Print, download, or mail order your card immediately after you pass. This certificate is valid for 3 years in CA.
